Guidelines for the Internship in North American Studies

How to use this guideline

The module "Research & Internship" aims at disclosing perspectives for future careers and to establish a professional network and practical experiences. Internships and research activities should cover a period of at least four weeks, but can be broken up into smaller units. Internships should be conducted in areas of work related to a student's individual career plans.

The following guidelines give an overview of some possible companies and institutes where internships are possible. They are primarily situated in and around Hannover.

Obviously, these are only suggestions. You can apply to other companies independently or combine your internship with a stay abroad. You may also apply for a scholarship to help fund a stay abroad. Please be sure to contact Prof. Mayer about your internship or research plans.

The organizations and companies listed below are categorized by their field. For each company, you will find an address, telephone number, e-mail address and, if applicable, some additional information about the range of the internship itself. If not stated differently, the e-mail addresses listed underneath each company should be used to contact them for an internship.

For each company, you will also find some information about the expectations they have for the possible internship. If there is no additional information about the duration of the internship, you can be an intern there for the minimum time of four weeks (as is required for the module). However, some companies only take in interns for a longer duration. Additionally, you will find information about the language requirements for some internships. If the companies are able to take interns during the pandemic, this will be stated as well.

Translation offices:

An internship in a translation office allows you to apply what you have learned in your English studies, while simultaneously allowing you to expand your skills in the field of translation. The institutions listed here deal with both simultaneous translation at conferences and the translation of documents that need to be notarized, such as diplomas, birth certificates, or contracts.
